In this contest constants are required to fill out & submit the required materials. At the night of the coronation, each contestant will introduce themselves on stage, model on stage, and will be required to read their essay on stage. A panel of judges will determine the winners. The judges will be looking for a young lady who possesses poise, personality, intelligence, charm and someone who will be able to represent the Wakarusa Maple Syrup Festival at different events through out the year.
